# What is the SRTS Infrastructure Program?

- HB 2017
- Dedicated \$10 million annually
- Increasing to \$15 million annually 2023
- Purpose: Build street safety projects in 1 mile radius of schools that help students walk and bike to school safely.





# Important Facts

- Projects must be within public right of way
- 40% cash match for the funds
  - (OTC) may reduce the cash match to 20%
    - when the project is within a city of 5,000 people or less,
    - or is near a Title I school,
    - or is along a “Priority Safety Corridor.”





# How the funds will be programmed?

- Rapid Response Program
- Technical Services
- Competitive Program





# Eligibility

- First Cycle – Title 1 Schools only
- Cities, counties, ODOT, tribes, and transit agencies
- Bikeway, walkway or crossing safety improvements
- Must be identified in a plan
- Signatures of roadway authority
- Letter of support from school district or school impacted
- Verification of match





# Program Timeline

## 1<sup>st</sup> Cycle

July 23, 2018: Solicitation Starts

August 31, 2018: Letter of Intent Due

October 15, 2018: Applications Due

October – November: Staff review

December 2018 – January 2019: SRTS Advisory Committee makes recommendation

February 21, 2019: OTC considers approval of project list

March 2019-2024: Agreements signed and projects built

Competitive Program	Minimum funding request = \$ 60k
	Maximum funding request = \$2M
Rapid Response Program	Minimum funding request = N/A
	Maximum funding request = \$500k

FY 2018-2019 = \$18.33M	2018 = \$8.33M 2019 = \$10M
FY 20-22 \$30M	2020 = \$10M 2021 = \$10M 2022 = \$10M
FY 23-24 \$30M	2023 = \$15M 2024 = \$15M
